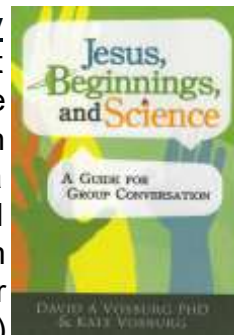

- Indian Museum Tour:** In conjunction with this, our own Loved By God Ministry is sponsoring an outing! We are touring the Indian Museum of Lake County, Ohio on Saturday, October 19th at 1pm. We will be receiving our own private tour hosted by the director who will talk to us about the native peoples in and around northeast Ohio. People have lived here as long ago as 10,000 years and many of their artifacts are from that time. The museum is at 7519 Mentor Ave., Suite A112. This is in the BACK of the strip mall on Mentor Ave. just west of the mall.
