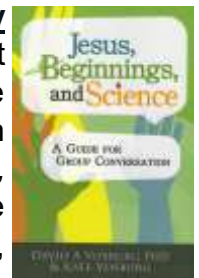


- **Online Giving:** If you'd like to support Advent's ministry electronically, scan this QR code to visit our online giving page.
