• **Blood Pressure Weekend:** Stop by the Parish Nurse office to have your BP checked.



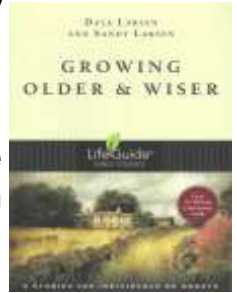
